- Represents the conversion upon vesting of restricted stock awards into common stock (the "Converted Common Stock "). The reporting person was granted, 3,120 restricted stock units on February 28, 2013, 4,000 restricted stock units on February 28, 2014 and 4,000 restricted stock units on February 28, 2015 of which 1/3 of the shares subject to the restricted stock units of each grant vested on February 28, 2014. Such restricted stock units were previously reported in Table II on a Form 4 filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 4, 2013, March 4, 2014 and March 3, 2015.
