- (1) Original option grant vests in three installments beginning on the first anniversary of the date of grant as listed in the "Date Exercisable" column.
- (2) Original option grant vests in four installments beginning on the first anniversary of the date of grant as listed in the "Date Exercisable" column.
- (3) Each restricted stock unit is the economic equivalent of one share of Envestnet, Inc. Common Stock
- (4) Each restricted stock unit represents the contingent right to receive one share of common stock upon the vesting of the unit.
- The reporting person was granted 11,600 restricted stock units on February 28, 2015. The remaining unvested restricted stock units will continue to vest as to 1/3 of the original number of shares subject to the restricted stock awards on each succeeding February 28th until fully vested.
- (6) These restricted stock units vest over a 3 year period, one third of the total amount vest on the first anniversary of the date of the grant of restricted stock; and then one-twelfth of the total amount vests on each three-month anniversary.

- This option grant vests over a 3 year period, one-third of the total amount vests on the first anniversary of the applicable date of grant and one-twelfth of the total amount vests on each three-month anniversary of the date of grant thereafter.
- The Reporting Person will earn a percentage of his performance stock unit award ("Banked Units") based on specific adjusted EBIDTA goals for the relevant performance period. This performance stock unit award vests over a 3 consecutive one-year performance periods, with 33.33% of Banked Units vesting following the First Performance Period, 50% of the outstanding Banked Units following the Final Performance Period, as described in the executive's employment agreement dated May 12, 2016 by and between the Company and the Reporting Person.
- Represents the issuance of Envestnet, Inc. common stock upon the vesting of restricted stock units effective May 29, 2017 (the "May Vested Restricted Stock Units"). The reporting person was granted 8,932 restricted stock units on February 29, 2016 of which one-twelfth of the total amount vested on May 29, 2017. Such restricted stock units were previously reported in Table II on a Form 4 filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 2, 2016.
- (10) The reporting person is reporting the withholding by Envestnet, Inc. of 341 shares of common stock to satisfy the reporting person's tax withholding obligations in connection with the vesting for tax purposes of the May Vested Restricted Stock Units to the reporting person on May 29, 2017.
